Semester 4-5 + breaks	One <b>seminar paper</b> in either 'linguistics' or 'literary and cultural studies', written in connection with one of the seminars, 5 KP. <b>The accepted seminar paper and 60KP are requirements to register for the BA exam. Since the deadlines for the exam are early in the next semester, those who wish to sit the BA exam in the winter term need to submit the seminar paper by: 31.08.; those who wish to sit the BA exam in the spring term need to submit the seminar paper by: 31.01.</b>	
	Module: Interphilologie: Sprachwissenschaft	Module: Interphilologie: Literaturwissenschaft
Semester 6**	Courses, etc. in one or both modules, 4 KP in total	
Semester 6	<b>BA exam</b> in the discipline (either 'English linguistics' or 'literary and cultural studies') in which the seminar paper was <i>not</i> written, 5 KP. Please note that the registration for the BA exam is early in the semester and announced on the website of Phil.-Hist. Studiendekanat.	

\* Depending on your capacity, you can also take the course on 'Communicating Academic Contents' (varying titles) earlier.
